Experience with multidisciplinary care for individuals with kidney disease is required.</p> <p>Additional specialized interest/training in home dialysis therapies, interventional nephrology, glomerulonephritis, acute kidney injury, chronic kidney disease, kidney stones, quality improvement, or other areas of clinical care for patients with kidney disease will be considered an asset, but not a requirement, for the successful applicant.</p> <p>60% clinical service in all areas of nephrology including ambulatory care (CKD, General Nephrology, GN), dialysis, hospital inpatient and consultation. Weeknight and weekend call (16 weeks of service, 3 - 4 half day clinics/week).</p> <p>15% education in the Division of Nephrology and Department of Medicine (Fellowship and Resident Training) and the Cumming School of Medicine (Undergraduate Medical Education).</p> <p>15% administration responsibilities within the Section of Nephrology.
