Nephrologist – Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Charlottetown

Health PEI is seeking a full-time Nephrologist to join a collegial group Nephrology physician as part of the PEI Provincial Renal Program. Primarily located at the Provincial Renal Clinic at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, this position will provide provincial coverage, including attending to other Health PEI facilities on a shared group rotation.

Health PEI provides a range of kidney care and related services through the PEI Provincial Renal Program to prevent, diagnose, and treat kidney disease including:

- In-center, outpatient hemodialysis at four hospitals
- Home therapies program - Peritoneal dialysis. We are also currently in the process of building a home hemodialysis program.
- Urgent hemodialysis: Queen Elizabeth Hospital ICU
- A large renal clinic with a broad variety of renal pathologies and over 100 renal transplant patients.
- An interventional program, including acute hemodialysis catheter insertion, kidney biopsies, tunneled permanent dialysis catheter and peritoneal bedside catheter insertions with access to fluoroscopy.

Health PEI a crown corporation, is responsible for the delivery of publicly funded health services in Prince Edward Island. Health PEI's head office is located at 16 Garfield Street, Charlottetown, PEI.

The successful candidate is expected to have an interest in supporting the interventional side of our program. Successful completion of a point of care ultrasound course to assess kidney morphology and to be able to exclude hydronephrosis is mandatory. Candidates with extra training in glomerular diseases will be favored along with candidates with a strong curriculum vitae in teaching. The province of PEI is in the process of establishing a medical school with teaching opportunities for QEH staff.

Prince Edward Island remains one of the most enjoyed gems of Eastern Canada. A perfect mix of urban and rural cultures (history based upon a culture of farming and fishing). Opportunities for professional development and personal enjoyment are hall marks of life on PEI. Position:

One (1) position beginning September 2024 with availability for earlier start date.

Remuneration:

Physicians have the option of choosing a salary, contract for service or fee-for-service payment modality.

Hours of Work:

- Full-time hours for a salaried physician are defined as 37.5 hours per week.
- Full-time contract-for-service hours is based on a maximum of 1,725 hours per year.
- Required to provide 1 in 3 on-call coverage for the provincial Nephrology service.

Incentives:

- Return-in-Service Grant may be available;
- Eligible moving expense reimbursement are available;
- Opportunity to teach Medical Learners and Residents with faculty appointment at affiliated universities;
- Access to hospital-based electronic patient record system with lab and x-ray reports from office; and
- Other incentives as per the Master Agreement.

Certifications and Other Requirements:

- FRCPC or eligibility for Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada certification
- Eligibility for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Prince Edward Island
- Appointment to the Health PEI Medical Staff and appropriate privileging
- Extra training in diagnosis and treatment of glomerular diseases is desirable and consider an asset
- Point-Of-Care ultrasound of the kidneys is mandatory
- Be involved in development and implementation of standards and polices
- Ability to drive and travel the island to various locations

Health Care Workers are required to provide proof of Covid-19 vaccination as per Health PEI's Covid-19 Immunization and Management Policy. If a new hire is unable to be vaccinated as a result of a medical exemption, they will be required to submit supporting documentation to Employee Health / Wellness and Safety.
