

Home Dialysis Fellowship Training Program

The Division of Nephrology at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre will be accepting applications for the 2023-2024 Home Dialysis Fellowship Training Program.

This is a 12-month fellowship that is fully accredited through the Department of Medicine at the University of Toronto. This fellowship will enable the successful candidate to have broad exposure to a growing home dialysis cohort in both peritoneal dialysis (PD) and home hemodialysis. The successful applicant will also develop expertise in PD access planning in attending dedicated access clinics and also learn to insert bedside peritoneal dialysis catheters.

Objectives:

- Fostering expertise in caring for patients receiving home-based therapies
- Develop expertise in inserting ultrasound-guided PD catheters
- Acquire skills and knowledge in identifying implementation practices for developing successful home dialysis programs
- Acquire basic skills in quality improvement methodology within home dialysis

Prerequisite Training: In addition to demonstrating a strong commitment to Home Dialysis, interested applicants must have completed at least two years of general nephrology training from an accredited program in Canada or abroad.

Salary: Compensation will be equivalent to the PGY6 salary as outlined by PARO (see here for details: <https://myparo.ca/starting-residency/#salary-and-benefits>)

3. Names of three references

The successful applicant will be notified on September 30th, 2022 and the expected start date will be July 3rd, 2023.
