### **Nephrology Position at Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC)**

Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre is looking for a nephrologist to join the current five nephrologists. The successful candidate will be expected to work in the current care model that includes a busy hospital-based service consisting of MRP responsibilities in addition to ICU/ward consults, hemodialysis rounds, peritoneal dialysis and home hemodialysis clinics, and a robust general nephrology and MCKC clinic.

Working at TBRHSC offers unique opportunities. Our nephrologists insert over 90% of all tunneled HD catheters, peritoneal dialysis catheters and temporary HD catheters, as well as performing kidney biopsies. The ability to perform these procedures is not a pre-requisite, however, the desire to do so and willingness to learn is. Our team finds that having the ability to perform these added skills increases our job satisfaction.

TBRHSC is a vibrant teaching hospital for the Northern Ontario School of Medicine and serves all of Northwestern Ontario. We have a large population of Indigenous people who are often underserved and struggle from a high burden of pathology. An interest in working with Indigenous populations would be an asset.
