Penticton Regional Hospital is a 158-bed Acute Care facility in the Okanagan Health Service Area and responsible for providing core medical and surgical specialty services to the surrounding population of approximately 90,000 people. PRH recently completed an expansion of the new David Kampe Tower, a state-of-the-art facility. The locum entails general nephrology work covering inpatient consultation, hemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis, chronic kidney disease and transplant clinics. It can include general internal medicine or intensive care unit work for interested physicians.
