

Nephrologist LOCUM NIAGARA HEALTH

The Department of Medicine, Division of Nephrology at Niagara Health seeks a nephrologist for a locum position covering both the inpatient and outpatient nephrology service. The start date of the position will be Sept 20th, 2021 and expected duration of coverage is 5 months.

Niagara Health is one of the largest multi-site health care systems in Ontario serving 434,000 residents within the Regional Municipality of Niagara. With 700 beds, 4,500 employees, 640 physicians and a \$500M budget, the NH provides a wide range of inpatient and outpatient services across six sites encompassing operations in Fort Erie, Niagara Falls, Niagara-on-the-Lake, Port Colborne, Welland and one million square foot state-of-the-art hospital in St. Catharines.

There are three in-center hemodialysis units in the Niagara region (St. Catharines, Niagara Falls, Welland) and an active Home Modalities Program including Peritoneal dialysis and Home Hemodialysis.

Physicians are expected to pursue a university faculty appointment and participate in academic activities within a strong regional community hospital setting.</p> <p>In addition to McMaster, Niagara Health is building strong ties with other regional academic providers such as Brock University and Niagara College.</p> <p>Niagara Health also shares a special relationship with St. Joseph's Hospital Hamilton Nephrology Program.</p>
